Our family chain is broken and

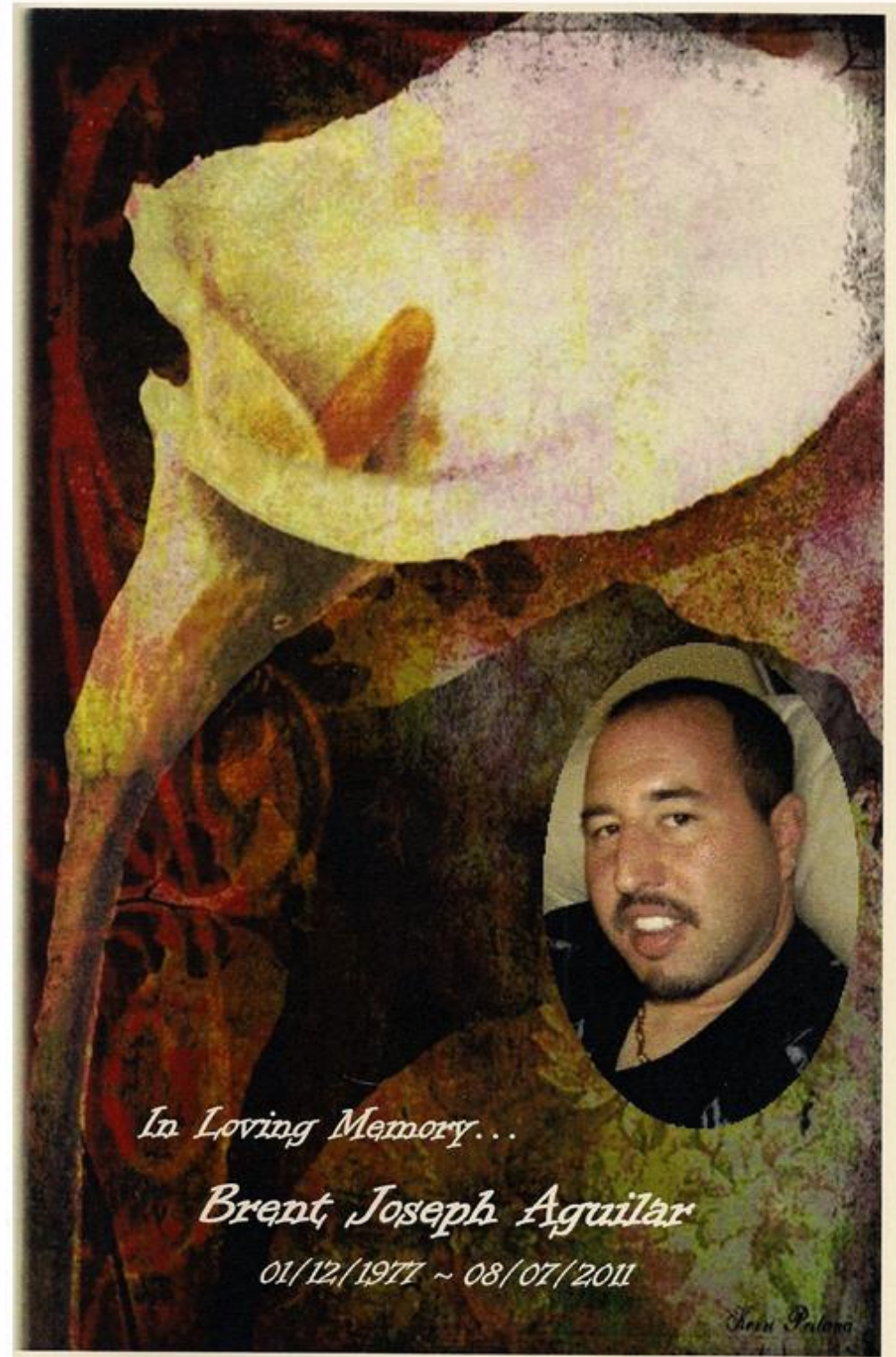
Nothing seems the same,
